Truck Maintenance Prior to Season 2022

General service

Oil leak in breather near air tanks in need of attention

Only one release valve for all three air tanks

Front shock absorbers need replacing

Clutch needs adjustment

Rivets behind cab on the bird compartment need replacing

Tropical roof damaged and in need of repair

Bird compartment leaks and in need of repair

Windscreen wiper blades need replacing

Park light passenger's side near the aerofoil is damaged and needs replacing

Battery terminal needs attention

Top air vent above rear door to bird compartment needs to be closed Mattress in sleeper cab needs thorough clean or replaced

Fuel card requires a PIN number at certain fuel stops in the north of the state.

Truck Driver's Expenses

Discussion was had as to whether the truck driver should be reimbursed for use of water from his private water supply to fill the water tanks on trucks every week of the race season and for the use of his private mobile phone.

Moved: Bob Hayes that the driver should be reimbursed at least half the \$150, [\$75] the driver outlaid on a prepaid SIM card for his private phone in order to enhance communications and record coordinates at each race point, and be paid \$30 for use of water from his private water supply to fill the water tanks on the truck.

PPMV-1

By this time all clubs, who ordered PMV vaccine through the Federation, will have received their order and have vaccinated any previously unvaccinated pigeons within their lofts. The vaccine will not assist pigeons who have contracted the virus but will provide positive immunity to those pigeons who have to date remained free of the virus.
