Truck Maintenance

Truck collided with a kangaroo Monday night 17 July 2023 which resulted in damage to a spotlight and damage to the bull bar. Fortunately, Merv Jupp has sourced a set of 8 inch, LED spotlights, for less than the replacement cost of the existing spotlights. The bull bar also requires attention by way of straightening

The Bull Bar was fixed and cost for head light globes weighed up in consideration of LEDs for the headlights. The cost for these being \$149; LED's considered preferable and agreed on by the board.

Payment of an \$80 nomination fee payable to the PRF by each non PRF flyer, payment to the PRF of \$1 per bird freight and payment to the ANRPB of \$10 per bird entry fee into the National. All non PRF competitors are to have PRF distances calculated for the National.

Downloading Video Recording of Liberations and Apparatus for Recording Temp, Co2 and Humidity

The challenge of retrieving video recordings of feed and water liberations and the reading of the instrument for measuring Co2 levels, temperature and humidity were discussed. The practicalities of removing the chip from the devices, for uploading the information onto the PRF website, having regard for the location of the truck. Matt Heedes suggested we obtain duplicate chips so that one can be uploaded while the other is with the driver for the purpose of recording the next liberation. Matt Heedes to explore the possibilities.

It was agreed that filming should take place, with Matt Heeds to follow up and assist with technical issues regarding driver recordings.

Sick Pigeons

We have received some constructive feedback from Board members relative to how best to approach the challenge of sick pigeons being entered into races and tossed on the Federation transporter. Sick pigeons have the potential to cause our birds serious health issues and disrupt our race program. For example, one member lost 9 pigeons to a particularly virulent strain of Rotavirus.

One suggestion is that we put forward a Notice of Motion to amend how we calculate the Flyer of the Year, namely;

[1] For Saturday afternoon basketing only, members have the opportunity to drop their worst two performances from the FOY points system. For example, for the Sprint Series, if there are seven [7] Saturday afternoon basketing races, only the best five results [5] are considered for FOY or;

[2] FOY points commence from Thursday night basketing only, as we are led to believe is the case in SA, Vic and NSW.

Any of the above proposals would require a Notice of Motion to be put to a Special General Meeting or an AGM to amendment the Race Rules, which would need the support of 51% of the members.

For ease of reference by members and to avoid special events clashing, Clubs are again requested to advise the Board of any special events due in the coming season, for example, Sires, Legacy auctions or other special event.

Labels on Federation Crates

In order to ensure every club is adequately catered for, no club is to load a Federation crate onto the truck unless it bears the appropriate club label, as per the Constitution.

Each member is entitled to one [1] crate only per week. For example, if you have 10 members, only ten crates are eligible to be loaded onto the Federation truck by your club.

Advertising PRF to Ethnic Clubs

Federation Publicity Officer has got quotes to advertise on the Philtimes Facebook Page. The advert will run for a full 10 days at the cost of \$230 +GST. The board agreed.

Appeals

In the event that a member elects to appeal a decision made against him/her, or relative to another member, they must first put their intention to appeal in writing including the grounds for appeal. The Board will not accept or act on an application to appeal without the appellant particularising their grounds for appeal.

Complaints

All complaints of any nature relative to pigeon racing must be in writing and submitted to the Board for consideration of action, if required.

Complaints – Local Authority

In the event of a complaint, if a member is compliant with local By-laws he/she should survive the complaints process, if not compliant it is very difficult to assist them.

Damaged Crates and Inserts

Please ensure all damaged crates are labelled with an appropriate tag addressed to Amalgamated Club, particularizing the fault with the crate. The faulty crate is then to be loaded onto Amalgamated's bay for forwarding to Amalgamated club for repair. Do not store damaged crates at your club.
