Leo has been in and around pigeon racing for 70 years and knows a good pigeon. He is also author of "Pigeon Racing: A Scientific Approach" and has a worldwide network within the pigeon racing fraternity. Leo has an excellent appreciation of pigeon racing and what it takes to make a good pigeon perform.

I only have two pair of full-time breeders and these youngsters are from them. These two pair without a shadow of doubt are the best, most consistent, pairs I have ever owned in just on 70 years in the sport and were only discovered by accident. A recent count shows these two pair have accrued 66 places including some very good wins. E.g. Riverton 100 (No.1 pair). A fed card this year two hens from the No.2 pair. Another, 3rd National from Nerren Nerren with a daughter of No.2 pair in which two sisters landed together 20 minutes in front of the field. The No.1 pair produce 11 flights quite regularly (as well as being very consistent breeders). The No.1 and 2 offspring have always been very good pool birds and several No.1 pair hens have accrued more than \$1,000 in pools each over years.

My Soontjen (sourced from the late Allan Brown of Riviera Lofts, San Remo, Victoria) are of long standing (20 years) and have always given of their best. The two sires here are cousins, although very quickly go back to the source birds of Jos Soontjen.

The hens of the No.1 and 2 pairs are sisters. Their Sire PRF.11.3452 was a Van Dyck Koopman cock gifted to me as a youngster by Bradley Phillips and is a brother to his 2011 PRF Fed young bird derby winner. (I subsequently lost 3452 in a sprint race).

Their Dam PRF.08.14448 (a Jos Thone bird) was gifted to me by David Van Aalst in October 2010. She is down from Bonk x Belle and Olympiad all round. (I only ever bred two off 14448) and these are the hens of the No.1 and 2 pair). **Pedigrees available**
