Treasurers Report.

Current balance in everyday working account \$17,541.11

Term Deposit \$72,839.70, earned \$2839.70 interest, renewed for 12 months at 4.6%, matures 13/5/2025.

Treasurer also presented the end of Financial report, a copy to be attached to the minutes.

Board agreed to proportion the Term Investment interest so that 50% of the interest earned on the Disease Management Fund goes back into the balance of the DM Fund and 50% goes into the ANRPB balance. Treasurer calculated it after the meeting as \$1283.82 to be added to DMF out of the \$2839.70 earned on the \$70,000 investment.

The FCI have approved suppliers with rings sun resistant and to world standard, no numbers are duplicated on rings. 5 euros from each sale will go to the FCI. Central Cumberland plan to access rings through FCI due to quality and price. Leo asked questions such as what details go on the ring, are we able to differentiate states, eg WA need PRF and SA need SA printed on Rings, other states as well Stephen to investigate whether FCI needs to printed on rings ?</p> <p>FCI congress in China 2026 Due to new membership it is important for a representative to attend from the Board to promote Australia. Paul motioned that the Board should support and pay travel and accommodation costs for a member to attend the congress. Donation to ANRPB by Vince Pedavoli	Vince held a pigeon auction through Hawa Brothers who kindly donated their services for no charge. Vince's birds brought a tidy sum and he has donated \$11500 to the ANRPB. These funds will be distributed as \$6500 to Legacy Australia as a donation and each of the 5 states will have \$1000 allocated for their National Race. 2024 Grand National.	<p>NSW Stephen advised Central Cumberland accepted the ANRPB grand national race for NSW and will transport other fliers. This year's grand national will include multiple federations and clubs. Stephen advised details for basketing will be sent out closer to the date. The race will be held in September.</p> <p>WA - Perth ANRPB Grand National was successfully held on 27th July 2024 - 500kms, Galena. Non-affiliated clubs to the PRF were charged \$2 per bird for freight plus the \$10 per bird entry for the Grand National.</p> <p>QLD - Philip Almond advised Nort Line St Lawrence 580km, invite everyone, no \$10 entry fee this year. Next year 2025 planning on 680 to 780km race.</p> <p>SA Emmdale 14th September \$10/bird entry fee applies. Russell reported that the Iron Triangle clubs (Port Augusta and Port Pirie) may not have any flyers as their season will be finished by then and he is still checking with Keith in the South East of the state. Free freight as birds are all prepaid in SAHPA.</p> <p>Victoria's National is held on 12th October from Dubbo. Tony advised that the sponsorship money from ANRPB will be divided \$250 to each Victorian Federation winner the \$10/bird does not apply in Victoria.
